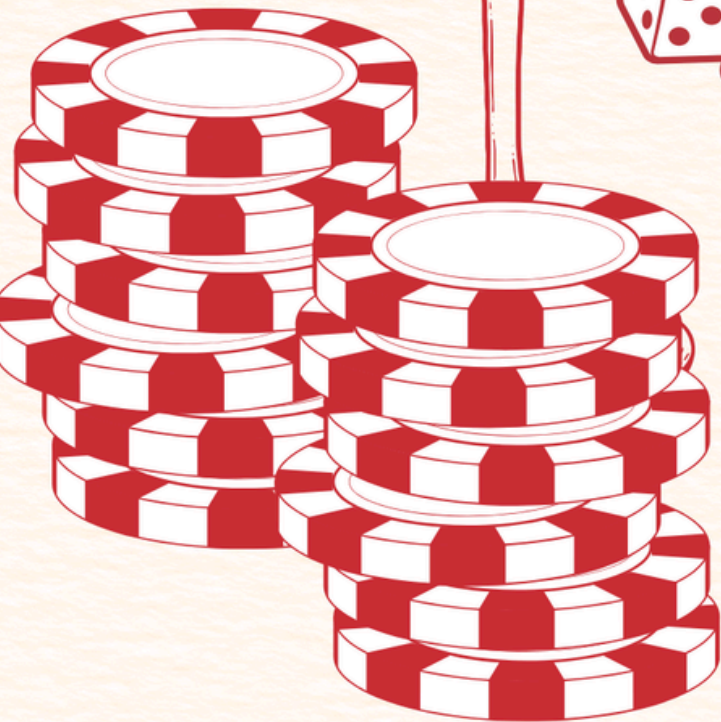

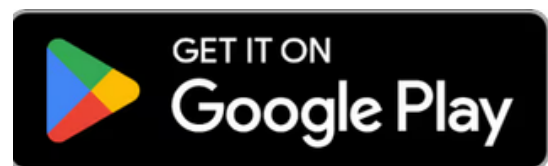

Eddie Garley at full forward kicked one of the two goals showing his natural ability in the role.

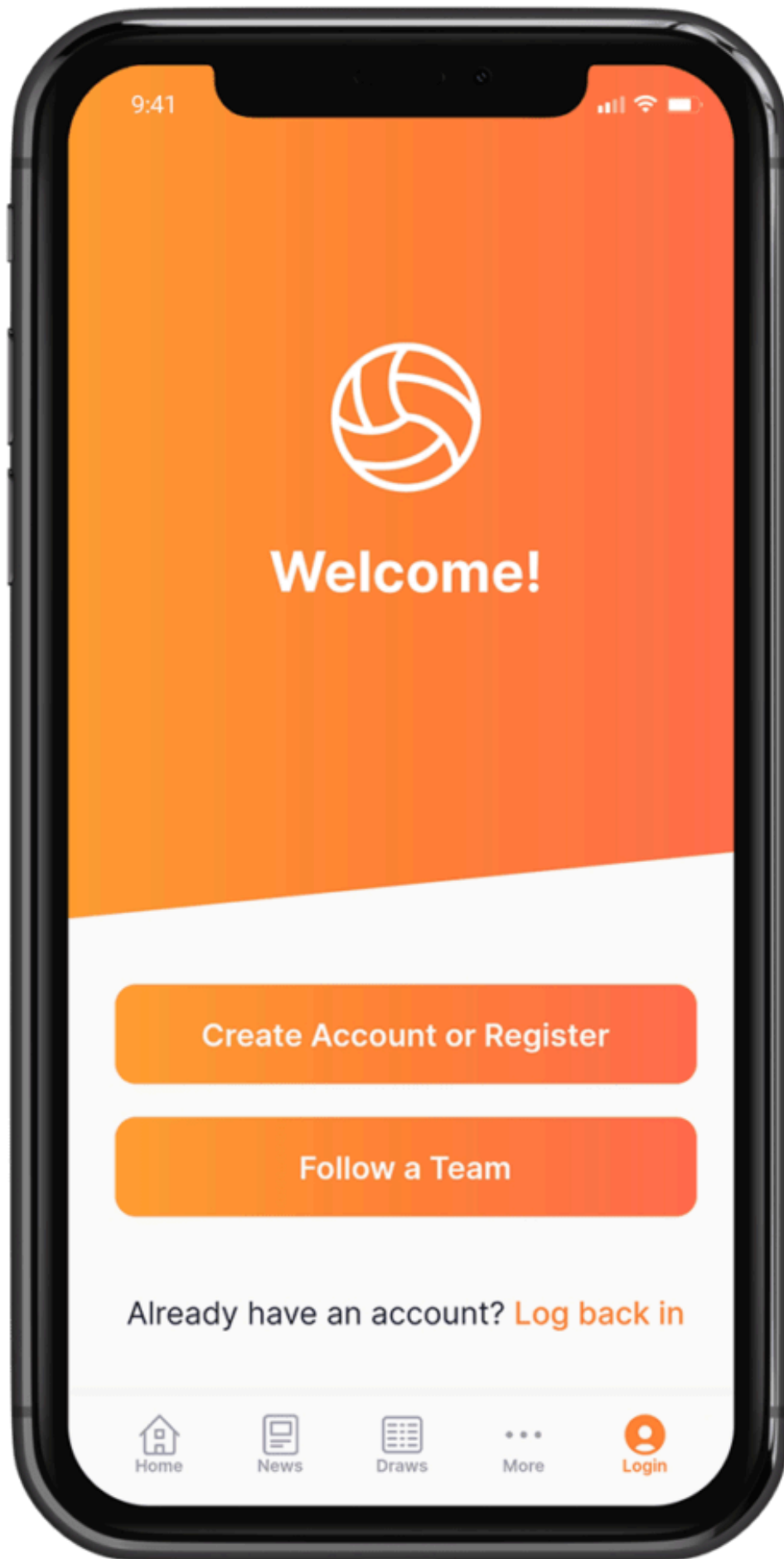
